

Stretched Funding



Free Entitlement funding is received term time which is 38 weeks of the year. We deliver the Free Entitlement "stretched" over the 51 weeks of the year. Jubilee Day Nursery is open. This means that 15 hours of funding per weekly entitlement, annually equating to 570 hours, is averaged out and delivered over 51 weeks, making the weekly entitlement 11.17 hours per week.

These hours are delivered to you free of charge. The remaining hours that your child is in attendance are chargeable.

If your child is entitled to 30 hours Free Entitlement, equating to 1140 hours annually, we will also stretch this to become 22.35 hours per week, again delivered free of charge. The remaining hours that your child is in attendance are chargeable.

For funded places, an "Extra Services and Facilities" charge is made. This covers the cost of everything that the Free Entitlement does not provide for as outlined in our Extra Services and Facilities page.

Free Entitlement is only intended to cover the cost of delivering high quality childcare and costs associated with the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage. It is not intended to cover any additional learning opportunities, experiences or consumables as offered within Jubilee Daycare's Enriched and Enhanced Provision.
